A Proven Model

The heart of HW-SC's success is the close bond formed between each student and their Youth Advocate (YA), a dedicated Hillside professional who provides support in three vital areas:

ACADEMIC

The Youth Advocate forms strong lines of communication with teachers and families, to identify and eliminate potential roadblocks to a student's school success. Private support allows YAs to help more students, while also funding the delivery of individualized tutoring services that supplement traditional classroom learning.

JOB READINESS

At HW-SC's Jobs Institute, students define their career goals, build soft skills and acquire practical experience through the Youth Employment Training Academy. Following YETA certification, they can find part-time jobs with engaged businesses in their community, earning money while boosting their workforce skills. With increased philanthropic support, YETA can reach more youth in need.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Through regular check-ins with families and other community resources, the YA provides guidance and advice that helps participants stay focused and on course. With greater private funding, more at-risk young people can benefit from these vital wraparound services facilitated by skilled Youth Advocates.



Results and Community Impact

\$1 invested in HW-SC yields \$8.52 in community benefits over the lifetime of employed/YETA-certified HW-SC graduates. Benefit-Cost Analysis conducted by the University of Rochester.

HW-SC served more than 3,800 students across all regions in the 2018-2019 school year.

Over 6,500 high school diplomas have been earned by HW-SC students since 1987.

93% on-time graduation rate for youth who stay in HW-SC in grades 9-12. Percentage climbs even higher among participants who work part-time with Employment Partners.
